

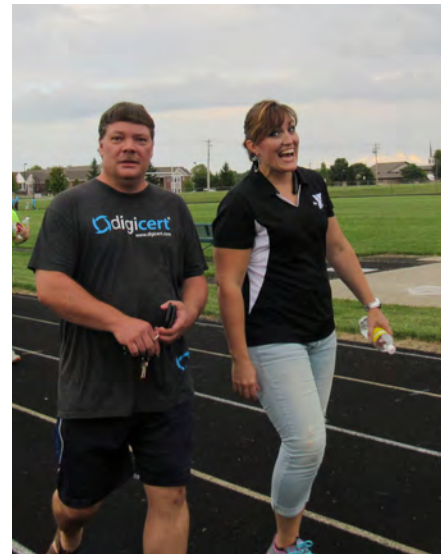

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PURPOSE: Building community is our cause! We recognize our opportunity and responsibility to impact the Huntington County Community in a positive, productive manner. The Battle of the Businesses is a fun way that we provide opportunities to be active, build workplace camaraderie, and bring our community together in a friendly competition.

DIVISIONS: A: Total employment of 200 or more employees
B: Total employment of 100-199 employees
C: Total employment under 100 employees

ELIGIBILITY: Any Huntington County business may compete.
All participants must be business employees and on the payroll at a part-time or full-time status. Temps and seasonal employees must be on the payroll, and not considered contract workers. Retirees, spouses, contractors and relatives are not eligible.
There is no limit as to the number of teams per business, per event, however; only the highest scoring team from each business will qualify for business points.

*The use of alcohol is prohibited. The presense of alcohol will result in immediate disqualification, and the individuals will be required to leave the premises.

ENTRY FEES: \$ 15.00 per team per event (except the following)
Bowling: \$20 per team
Golf: \$35 per team

TO REGISTER: Businesses must have all information completed on the ENTRY FORM and EVENT ROSTER FORMS. Both forms and fees must be returned to the Parkview Huntington Family YMCA by **Friday, August 24, 2018**.

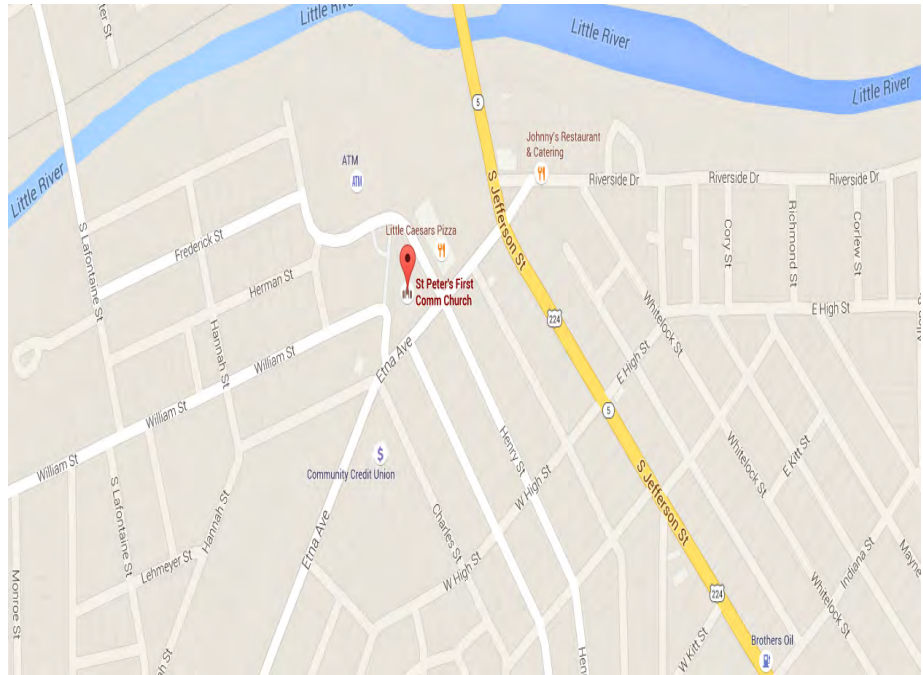

TUG OF WAR

TEXT ALERTS

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Event Description:

Teams of four will face off in a tug of war. A time limit will be imposed, with the winner being decided by the location of the flag when time is called.

Teams will consist of four members. Men/Women/Coed
Coed division must consist of two males and two females

Event Rules:

1. Teams win by pulling the opposing team across mid point of neutral zone.
2. Teams will have 30 seconds to prepare to pull before the "start". There will be no lying on the ground or swinging/swaying while pulling.
3. Cleats or body weights of any kind are prohibited.
4. "Sitting" is prohibited. Participants who fall will be given an opportunity to stand up, if they do not comply after 30 seconds, the team will be disqualified.
5. Rope may not be wrapped around any individual in any manner.
6. Gloves are allowed.
7. Double elimination.

PICKLE BALL

Event Description:

Games will be played to 11 with a 10-minute time limit.

Teams of two. Men/Women/Coed

Event Rules:

Serving:

To properly serve the ball, the player must keep one foot behind the back line and strike the ball with an underhand swing, aiming at the service court located diagonally over the net, and clearing the no-volley zone. Service starts from the right hand court. Only one fault is allowed. In the case of doubles, both players get to serve once, and then the serve is taken over by the opposing player/team.

Double-Bounce Rule:

The receiving team must let the serve bounce and the serving team must let the return of the serve bounce before playing it. Once these two bounces have occurred, the ball can either be volleyed or played off the bounce, provided they are not within no-volley zone within 7 feet of the net (marked on the court).

A **Fault** is committed when the ball:

- Touches any part of the non-volley zone on the serve (including the line).
- Is hit out of bounds
- Does not clear the net
- Is volleyed from the non-volley zone
- Is volleyed before a bounce has occurred on each side

Scoring

A team shall score a point only when serving.

After a fault is made by the receiving team, and a point is scored by the serving team, the serving team's players switch sides of court and the same player will continue to serve. When the serving team makes its first fault, the serving team's players will stay in the same side of the court, and the second partner will then serve. When they make their second fault, they will stay in their same court positions, and turn the ball over to the other team. Players switch sides of the court only after scoring.

5. Nets will be set at Women's height for coed games.

CORNHOLE

Event Description:

Double elimination tournament. Teams of two will play one game to 21 points to determine a winner. Games will be timed.

Teams will consist of two members. Men/Women/Coed

Men/Women: Saturday, September 15, 3:30 pm (Huntington North High School)

Event Rules:

1. Scoring: Cancellation scoring will be used, i.e., corn bags in-the-hole and on the board by opponents during an inning or half of an inning in doubles play cancel each other out. Only non-cancelled corn bags are counted in the score for the inning.
2. Winning: The match shall be played until the first team reaches (or exceeds) 21 points at the completion of an inning. The winning team does not need to win by two or more points. If the time limit forces the conclusion of a game, the team in the lead becomes the winner.
3. Ties: If the match is tied at 21 or more at the end of an inning, play continues until one team or the other achieves a higher score at the end of an inning and wins the match.
Teams must use the equipment provided.
4. Players will not be allowed to bring their own bags.

Businesses are encouraged to make donations or sponsor their walkers. However, this is not a requirement. All proceeds from the event will go directly to suicide prevention efforts in Huntington County. Any walker who raises donations in the amount of \$50 or more will receive a free Walk for Hope t-shirt.



BOWLING
