

KIM LEAGUE RULES

Pre K – K League

**The PreK league plays on 6-foot rims.
The Kindergarten League plays on 7-foot rims.**

- 1. Games will consist of four running clock quarters of 5 minutes each. The clock will stop only for official time out (two timeouts allowed per game).**
- 2. Each player must play a minimum of two quarters. All players should play equal minutes when possible.**
- 3. No one can foul out. However, the referee (or hopefully the coach) may sit a player for excessive fouls or unnecessary rough play.**
- 4. Free throws WILL NOT BE SHOT in this league. If foul is called, ball will be inbounded near half court.**
- 5. Man to man defense is required at all times. No pressing is allowed.**
- 6. There will be NO overtime played in the PreK - K league. Games may end in a tie.**
- 7. The game ball will be the 27.5-inch size basketball.**

Special Note: Practice for this League takes place right before each Saturday game. Example – Schedule states starting time on Saturday at 8:30 am.....means practice starts at 8:30 am and game begins approx 15 minutes later. Coaches are allowed on the court to instruct the players during the game.

Coaches are reminded that this league is a developmental league. We build Y Youth Programs around competition, sportsmanship, and the “Y” core values of Caring, Honesty, Respect and Responsibility.

The referee decisions are final and will not be overruled.
